POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT
Community Corrections – Residential Staff

Hamilton County Community Corrections has immediate openings for **Living Unit Coordinators**. The agency is in the 4th largest county in Indiana, directly north of Indianapolis in the county seat of Noblesville and provides services to justice-involved individuals that are required to complete a period of community-based supervision.

Living Unit Coordinators, in collaboration with other agency team members, oversee and care for those justice-involved individuals assigned to the agency's Residential Level of Supervision. They have daily interaction with participants including modeling pro-social behavior and assisting with skill building. They also monitor compliance with individualized case management plans and compliance with level of supervision expectations.

Qualified candidates should be able to demonstrate an ability to work independently with minimal supervision, as well as possess strong interpersonal skills. They should possess a minimum of a high school degree with significant work experience. Experience and/or course work in criminal justice is preferred. They must also possess a valid Indiana driver's license and demonstrate a safe driving record. The full-time position has a beginning salary of \$51,400.13 (\$24.71 hourly). Also provided is an excellent health care plan that includes medical, dental, vision and pharmacy coverage for employees and their families. Additional benefits include a retirement plan, deferred compensation, as well as paid vacation time and paid holiday time.
